

Jennings State Forest

Jennings State Forest contains 20 miles of horse trails and 14.5 miles of hiking/biking trails as well as canoeing, camping, swimming, and regulated hunting and fishing. The forest is part of the Great Florida Birding Trail and is home to an abundance of wildlife. Raccoon, otter, alligator and wading birds can be seen along North Fork Black Creek and other tributaries while white-tailed deer. wild turkey, hawks and songbirds can be found in the uplands.
