






Parker and His Ball!







Our family has been keeping bees in our Hallsley backyard since the spring of 2014. Shortly after moving to Richmond, we participated in an introduction to beekeeping class at Lewis Ginter Botanical Gardens. Since then, we have joined the local Rockwood Park Backyard Beekeepers Association, meeting monthly to confer with other local beekeepers, and we installed our first hives in 2014. Biringer Builder's John Waters was kind enough to allow our bees to move in before we did!

We have been fortunate enough to harvest honey several, though not all, years since keeping bees. But, we feel the most important role as a small-scale, backyard beekeeper is in nurturing pollinators in our gardens and backyard habitats. These insects are remarkable and necessary contributors to our natural world. East-West has made valuable efforts to keep Hallsley pollinator-friendly in their no-spray zone along Bedwyn, for example. Pollinators appreciate natural plantings that are native to the area and help to keep all of our gardens and flowers growing well.

We find that keeping bees brings our family together in new ways. We often go as a team to the hives to complete bi-monthly hive inspections, make sugar water to feed the bees, and harvest honey in the late spring and early fall, as supplies allow. We have also enjoyed participating in and planning the Rockwood Park Backyard Bee Festival. We facilitate activities for children, monitor a drone bee petting zoo, and sell bee-themed pillowcases together. Even the dog really enjoys the sweet drippings that may come her way.

Many people are wary of bees when they are buzzing around outside, but left alone, they are not aggressive. In fact, we started by obtaining docile, Italian queens to ensure their non-aggressive disposition. We have enjoyed learning bee biology and working to responsibly keep honeybees, offering ourselves and our neighbors the benefit of some efficient and productive pollinators. There are mugs and bottles targeted to sports enthusiasts, outdoorsy types, and extreme adventurists, but as Tracee Mathes saw it, there weren't any for the average woman ... the busy mom, girl on the go, or boss lady ... who wanted an uber-insulated and ultra-cute drinkware option. That gave the lifelong entrepreneur an idea. "I noticed there was no premium hydration company offering the variety of cup shapes women want and certainly not in colors that appeal to a female demographic. Mathes, a Richmond native and Hallsley resident since 2010, set out to meet that need in January 2017 when she launched SWIG, offering premium drinkware with women in mind. The company's cups, tumblers, and bottles rely on the same insulation technology that keeps other stainless steel hydration vessels cold or hot, including vacuum insulation, stainless steel double-walls, and copper-coated linings. But SWIG differs from its competitors with its creative and appealing designs. SWIG offers more shapes, sizes, and color choices (20!) than anyone else on the market, but what really sets them apart is their insulated stainless steel stemless wine cup ... a SWIG original creation that took the marketplace by surprise!

"Wine and wine accessories are very on-trend right now, and there was no stainless steel, insulated, stemless wine cup on the market, so we created one, and the response was unbelievable!" said Mathes. "We focused on a shape that was comfy to hold and made them in irresistible colors and finishes. Before we could blink, we had sold over 1.2 million cups and developed quite the following."

SWIG's stemless wine cup is an inventive, portable way to enjoy wine at the perfect temperature–indoors or outdoors. While other companies have jumped on the bandwagon, Mathes says SWIG is the brand customers always ask for when searching for this style.

The company makes colored cups, tumblers, and bottles in an array of eye-catching colors from pearl and rose gold to coral and hydrangea, and their branding is on-target for the female demographic they serve. The designs make SWIG a far cry from ordinary hydration vessels. Mathes says as a designer it's rewarding to see consumers value something she created. "Let's be honest, it the grand scheme of life it's just a cup ... but ... they are pretty to look at and work great. They also make a great gift, and it just makes your heart happy when using one," said Mathes.

While SWIG's claim to fame is its 12-ounce stemless wine cup, all of SWIG's products are geared toward busy, stylish women and moms. Its 17-ounce bottles appeal to exercise buffs who want to throw it in their bag and go, its 20- and 30-ounce tumblers are popular for morning motivation like coffee and tea, while the company's 50-ounce travel bottles make a splash with outdoor enthusiasts and hold two full bottles of wine. And they just rolled out their 6-ounce stemless champagne flute, which was another immediate success.

SWIG has quickly grown to employ 15 amazing women and is currently hiring several more positions while also looking for a new corporate office location in Richmond, VA, since they have outgrown their existing one. Even before its launch, it was clear Mathes would be an entrepreneur to be reckoned with. "I have always 'hustled'." At age 8, I sold puppies from a wagon in our neighborhood, at 12, I sold stationary door-to-door, in college, I started a custom gift-basket business, at age 30, I opened two retail stores, and now, at 45, I am still full of ideas! I have a masters degree in sociology with a focus on consumer research," she said. "I was an executive in sales and marketing for NBC12 and Media General before stepping out to open my store in Carytown and to follow my passion. I am a risk taker, and I will work endlessly to make an idea work! And SWIG is not my first company, nor did it happen overnight. I have spent the past 10 years developing two other successful brands in the wholesale/retail industry-Occasionally Made and Fanfare."

As for the future of SWIG, Mathes says she plans to grow the brand to include all types of hydration and insulation products including cups, barware, coolers, and coozies, with a goal of adding products to the line every six months. SWIG also offers a custom-printed division for companies and events that want to add their logo to a SWIG, and they are pursuing co-branded licensing deals with companies such as Vineyard Vines, Simply Southern, and Mossy Oak.

Mathes attributes SWIG's loyal customer base in part to the company always putting customers first. It offers a complete refund to buyers who aren't completely wowed by the product, for any reason, as well as a one-year warranty on every item.

While men enjoy SWIG's products, too, the line remains at its core a female-oriented brand. Mathes says she plans to continue building a brand focused on the average woman who wants a stylish, well-made product for her on-the-go lifestyle.

Mathes grew up here. She attended Clover Hill High School, University of Richmond (bachelor's), and University of VA (master's). While Mathes' husband, Ralph, is not an employee of the company, he is deeply involved and supports the business efforts in many ways. Ralph owns a freelance design company, Black Rooster Design, and consults with SWIG. Their younger son, Ty, attends sixth grade at Millwood and enjoys basketball, track, and video gaming. Mathes' older son, Cameron, graduated from Manchester High School and lives in Carytown. Their family attends Clover Hill Assembly of God and enjoys decorating, renovating—and drinking wine from SWIGs, of course!



Reading between the Wines BOOK CLUB


Come Join Us

Summer is here, and hopefully, everyone will have time to relax by the pool with a good book. Hallsley's Reading Between the Wines Book Club will continue to meet through summer on the third Tuesday of each month at 7 p.m. in the clubhouse. Our June book is *Sunburn: A Novel* by Laura Lippman. As a group, we select both the popular books that you'll find on the bestseller lists as well as ones you may never have heard about but are well-worth the time.

Last year, Reading Between the Wines Book Club read *One Good Mama Bone* by Bren McLain. McLain came to The Little Bookshop at Sycamore Square in Midlothian promoting her first novel, and one of our members happened to be there to hear her talk about the book and her inspiration for writing it. McLain has a gift for character development and brings them to life. Warning: it's a tear-jerker but well-worth it! This book would be a great addition to your poolside summer reading list. Below is a synopsis.

Set in early 1950s rural South Carolina, *One Good Mama Bone* chronicles Sarah Creamer's quest to find her "mama bone," after she is left to care for a boy who is not her own but instead is the product of an affair between her husband and her best friend and neighbor, a woman she calls "Sister." When her husband drinks himself to death, Sarah, a dirt-poor homemaker with no family to rely on and the note on the farm long past due, must find a way for her and young Emerson Bridge to survive. But the more daunting obstacle is Sarah's fear that her mother's words, seared in her memory since she first heard them at the age of six, were a prophesy, "You ain't got you one good mama bone in you, girl."

When Sarah reads in the local newspaper that a boy won \$680 with his grand champion steer at the recent 1951 Fat Cattle Show and Sale, she sees this as their financial salvation and finds a way to get Emerson Bridge a steer from a local farmer to compete in the 1952 show. But the young calf is unsettled at Sarah's farm,



crying out in distress and growing louder as the night wears on. Some four miles away, the steer's mother hears his cries and breaks out of a barbed-wire fence to go in search of him.

Luther Dobbins, the man who sold Sarah the steer, has his sights set on winning, too, and, like Sarah, he is desperate but not for money. Dobbins is desperate for glory, wanting to regain his lost grand-champion dynasty, and he will stop at nothing to win. Emboldened by her lessons from Mama Red and her budding mama bone, Sarah is committed to victory even after she learns the winning steer's ultimate fate. Will she stop at nothing, even if it means betraying her teacher?

McClain's writing is distinguished by a sophisticated and detailed portrayal of the day-to-day realities of rural poverty and an authentic sense of time and place that marks the best Southern fiction. Her characters transcend their archetypes, and her animal-as-teacher theme recalls the likes of *Water for Elephants* and *The Art of Racing in the Rain*.

4 - Eggs


1/4 Cup Parmesan Cheese

DIRECTIONS

1. Pre-Heat Oven to 450 degrees and line a sheet pan with parchment paper.

Eggs in a Cloud

- 2. Separate the eggs. Crack the eggs in the Small Stainless Steel Mixing Bowl. Carefully remove the yolk with the Egg Separator. Place each yolk in its own Small Prep Bowl.
- 3. Using an electric hand-held mixer, whip the whites at a high speed until stiff peaks form, about 2 - 3 minutes.
- 4. Take the Mini Mix 'N Scraper and gently fold the Parmesan Cheese into the egg white mixture. Then divide the egg whites into 4 "cloud" shapes on the baking sheet. Using a tablespoon, carefully make a little well in the center of each cloud.
- 5. Bake for 3 minutes and remove from oven. Gently slide an egg yolk into each well. Bake for another 3 minutes.
- 6. Gently remove with a spatula and enjoy!!




