



get Grill'n!



resident recipe

My husband is the Grill Master in our household. His number one tip is *Indirect Heat*. *Indirect Heat* makes for a slower cook which allows the meat to cook while maintaining the juices in the food. It also prevents the outside of the food from being burnt while the inside is cool or undercooked. Your grilled meats and chicken will cook uniformly without burning.

The same theory goes for cooking vegetables on the grill. For vegetables that are coated in olive oil and need to be turned often, it is best to put them in some type of grilling basket. Our favorite is the Pampered Chef BBQ Grill Basket. Cook for about 20 minutes until the vegetable is your desired softness.

The vegetable we grill the most in our household is corn on the cob. The technique we use is very simple - place the corn, husk and all, onto the grill following the indirect heat method. Turn frequently and leave on the grill for about 30 minutes. Super simple and perfect corn every time!

Usually, we don't think of dessert when we think of grilling but there are some really fun recipes that can be done. A favorite is grilled pineapple. Once your pineapple is sliced, spray each side with some olive or coconut oil. Place on grill for 2 minutes on each side. (This can also be done inside on the stovetop on a grill pan). Plate and serve with a scoop of vanilla ice cream along with a drizzle of caramel sauce - YUMM!







Meet Tucker!



Meet Pitch!



Listed below are descriptions of the wines featured at this Uncorked event. Hunter Boxley, owner of The Vino Market, has also graciously shared with us some fascinating information from his vast wine knowledge.

Featured Wines:

Field Recordings "Fiction" Red Blend 2015 - Paso Robles, California: \$19.99

Winemaker Andrew Jones has made this his go to red for almost any situation. It's big and spicy yet not overly extracted or flabby. There is a brightness or freshness to this wine that makes you crave another sip. It is great with beef, pasta, burgers, pizza, or anything else you'd whip up on a fun evening with friends. A steal at about \$20. It's a blend of 7 different grape varietals with Zinfandel making up almost half.

Brandborg Pinot Gris2015- Umpqua Valley, Oregon: \$16.99

Sue and Terry Brandborg farm and make this fantastic small production wine in their boutique winery in the town of Elkton, Oregon with a population of 193. (Elkton had a boom year in 2013 when 32 new folks moved in to town.) The wine is a blend of 2 separate and unique vineyards. One gives tropical richness and the other brightens the final blend with fresh pear and apple notes. It is a great choice with Salmon or roasted oysters. (Trust me on this one...We ate over 100 BBQ'd oysters and lots of other food well into the evening on my visit last year.) Great wines AND people!

Boxley's Notes from The Vino Market

We are so careful these days about what we put in our bodies. We buy organic produce. We seek out sustainably raised protein. We rise at dawn on days off to get the best from our local farmers. Then, many of us buy something resembling wine. It's not your fault. You lead a hectic life. Time is short. Decisions need to be made. You know you like that wine with the catchy name. It's tasty! It usually doesn't give you much of a headache. But, what's actually in it?

Try this out: Google the term "wine additives" or anything similar and spend a couple of minutes reading. FACT: 87% of the wine commercially sold worldwide is made or controlled by 4 companies! Think about that the next time you pick up a cute label at the grocery store.

We've grown to think of wine as a brand like our beers or spirits. Jack always tastes like Jack. Bud always tastes like Bud. Cupcake always tastes like Cupcake. Wine shouldn't taste the same every time.


Good wine (cost not important) is a natural living thing! When it's made well by conscientious people that treat their vineyards and workers well, it's a thing of beauty. It should speak of where and when it came. It should be unique. AND, it's actually good for you. Those 4 companies spend billions telling you what to drink. They also spend money so you will not know what they put in the bottle. They don't want you to know. But, now you do!




