Stacy Gray's Distinguished Gentleman Of Nottoway



tacey and Charlie Gray, college sweethearts from East Carolina University, landed in Hallsley in late June of 2016. Charlie works as a manager for a reporting and analytics team at Pentagon Federal Credit Union while Stacey works at the Nottoway Intermediate School. While they both love the friendly atmosphere of Hallsley and having a "Director of Fun" who brings a sense of community to the neighborhood, Stacey quickly recognized the giving nature of Hallsley residents. In the midst of the excitement and preparations surrounding the welcome of their first child (Robbie Gray) this month, Stacey launched a new boys youth empowerment program with some help from her Hallsley neighbors.

Stacey Gray spends her days working as the School Counselor for Nottoway Intermediate School. This small rural school has approximately 300 students in the fifth and sixth grades. The majority of the students are considered economically disadvantaged with a high population of low-to-moderate family incomes. While her job description involves providing academic counseling, small group and personal counseling and classroom guidance lessons, her heart saw another need and longed to help. Sheryl shares, "Unfortunately, many of our students do not have positive male role models to look up to. Our students are at that critical developmental period in which they are beginning to form their adult identity."

In response to this need, Stacey Gray and some fellow coworkers embarked on a plan to impact the young men at







Nottoway Intermediate School in a positive way. Influenced by a program at Falling Creek Middle School, Stacey and her team created and launched the Distinguished Gentlemen of Nottoway program. Stacey describes the program as being for

empowerment, mentoring and academic support group. Our goal is to emphasize to our guys that they can be successful, hardworking, responsible, and dedicated young gentleman in our community if they believe in themselves. 


student life KATIE KRASNER

CHICKEN LASAGNA ROLL-UPS

resident recipe



CHICKEN LASAGNA ROLL-UPS

INGREDIENTS

- 8 Lasagna Noodles
- 1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breasts cooked or rotisserie chicken
- · 1 cup part-skim ricotta cheese
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 2 Cups Tomato Sauce
- · 11/2 cup shredded part skim mozzarella





DIRECTIONS

- Boil and salt the water for lasagna noodles. Cook according to box, drain and then place the lasagna in a bowl of cool water.
- Pre-heat the oven to 350 degrees. Spray 9x12 pan (I prefer to use a stoneware pan) with olive oil using Kitchen Spritzer.
- Using a Food Chopper, chop the chicken into thinly shredded pieces.
- In a large bowl, mix the chicken, ricotta, Parmesan, 1/2 cup Mozzarella and salt until the chicken is well coated.
- Using Chef tongs, remove the lasagna noodle from the cold water and pat dry with a paper towel. Place 1 noodle on a large cutting board. On the edge closest to you, use a medium scooper and place 2 scoops of the mixture. Spread the mixture out so that it covers one-third of the noodle. With your fingertips, roll the noodle into a tube (lift the edge of the pasta with filling and roll). Transfer seam-side down to the stoneware dish. Repeat with the remaining sheets.
- Pour the sauce around the roll-up but not on top. Sprinkle with the remaining mozzarella and bake uncovered, 25 30 minutes.
- · Serve and add tomato sauce on top to your liking.
- * Dana's Tip you can prepare these during the day, up to the point of pouring the sauce and mozzarella on top, and keep in the fridge.

 Take out while you pre-heat the oven and add the final steps. Enjoy!!

I can't tell you the number of folks I've met over the years who were completely disappointed by their sod lawn full of bare spots and weeds after only a couple of years from installation. Sod provides an instantly thick, green, weed free

yard of the month

lawn. However, sod is not artificial turf. Artificial turf is made from nylon and made to look like grass. Sod is a section of grass-covered surface soil held together by matted roots and laid over bare soil. Sod is grown at sod farms with ideal amounts of sunlight, water and nutrients and then cut up and re-installed in often challenging conditions.

Here are some basic tips for getting your sod lawn established and keeping it looking good for years to come. Get your soil tested to determine the pH level and whether soil will need amending. Improve compacted soil, often found in abundance in the Chesterfield County area, by core aerating the soil each spring before the growing season. This will improve the movement of water, air and nutrients to the roots and strengthen your sod. Provide regular feeding and weed control treatments to keep weed seed from sprouting and choking out your sod. Follow a consistent watering schedule when hot and dry alternating days to promote strong healthy roots. Cut grass tall and allow the clippings to fall -- shading and cooling the roots while supplying nutrients and promoting micro-organism activity to improve the health of the soil. Follow these tips and your sod lawn can go from a disappointment to a candidate for Yard of the Month.



Even corn is good for your


